Please Note: Only members of 4-H, FFA & Grange are eligible to enter.

4-H JUNIOR DOG SHOWS HEALTH RULES:

All dogs must have current rabies, dis-temper, and parvo shots. Parvo MUST be dated within 6 months prior to the show. PROOF OF UP-TO-DATE VACCINATION MUST BE ATTACHED TO ENTRY FORMS. ALL DOGS MUST HAVE THIS PAPER WORK.

4-H JUNIOR DOG SHOWS RULES:

1. Judging will be according to the American Kennel Club guidelines.
2. No bitches in season.
3. More than one dog will be permitted as long as they are not in same class.
4. Entries limited to PROJECT DOGS only.
5. Project leader's signature is required on entry form. Age of exhibitor as of Jan 1, 2009 must be on entry form.
6. You must have successfully completed the 2008-2009 year in dog care, including record keeping.
7. Customary attire is 4-H, FFA & Grange uniforms. Neatness is counted.
8. Properly fitted collar and six foot (6') lead are required for obedience. (NO CHAIN LEADS). Show leads should be appropriate for your dog's type.
9. Class changes due to change of status shall be made one half hour prior to the start of show. Clarification to be vocal.
10. No one under the age of 9 years as of Jan. 1, 2009 may enter the Dog Show; they can make posters and enter in Division 740 Class 7 in 4-H PRIMARY DEPARTMENT.

DIVISION 1

OBEDIENCE

CLASS:

1. **SUB-NOVICE** -All work done on lead: heel, figure 8, stand for examination, re-call and finish. Group exercises: one minute sit and three minutes down stay.
2. **NOVICE** - On lead: heel, figure 8. Off lead: heel, stand for examination, re-call and finish. Group exercises: one minute sit and three minutes down stay. NO DOG WITH A.C.D. OR EQUIVALENT MAY COMPETE IN NOVICE.
3. **OPEN** - All off lead: heel, figure 8, drop on recall, retrieve on flat, retrieve over high jump, and broad jump. Group exercise: out of sight three minute sit, five minutes down stay. Exhibitor must provide regulation size jumps and dumbbell. NO DOG WITH A. U.D. OR EQUIVALENT MAY COMPETE IN OPEN.

4. **UTILITY** -All off lead: signal exercise, scent discrimination, directed retrieve, moving stand, and examination and di-rected jumping.

SHOWMANSHIP

CLASS:

- 1. NOVICE JUNIOR DOG** - Grades 4 through 8 from 2008-09 school year having NEVER shown prior to the close of the Antelope Valley Fair en-tries in Dog Showmanship, Dog handling, Breed or Obedience class at a 4-H Dog Show, or any other dog show, match, practice match or trial.
- 2. INTERMEDIATE JUNIOR DOG** -Grades 4 through 8 from 2008-09 school year, having shown prior to the close of the Antelope Valley Fair entries in a Dog Showmanship or Dog handling class, at a 4-H or Grange dog show, or any other dog show, match, practice match or trial but not having received three blue ribbons.
- 3. ADVANCED JUNIOR DOG** - Grades 4 through 8 from 2008-09 school year, having shown prior to the close of the Antelope Valley Fair entries, having received three blue ribbons in Dog Showmanship or Dog Handling classes.
- 4. NOVICE SENIOR DOG** - Grades 9 through 12 from 2008-09 school year, having NEVER shown prior to the close of the Antelope Valley Fair en-tries in Dog Showmanship or Dog Han-dling, Breed or Obedience class at a 4-H Dog Show or any other dog show, match, practice match or trial.
- 5. INTERMEDIATE SENIOR DOG** -Grades 9 through 12 from 2008-09 school year, having shown prior to the close of the Antelope Valley Fair entries in Dog Showmanship or Dog Handling, but not having received three blue ribbons.
- 6. ADVANCED SENIOR DOG** - Grades 9 through 12 from 2008-09 school year, having shown prior to the close of the Antelope Valley Fair entries, having received three blue ribbons in Dog Showmanship or Dog Handling classes.

Note: The first & second place winner of the junior classes will compete in the Junior Division of the Small Livestock Round Robin. The first & second place winner of the senior classes will compete in the Senior Division of the Small Livestock Round Robin.
