MISSION: The Mission of the California State Grange is to support family and community through leadership.

Goals: The goals of the California State Grange are to enhance our public image, increase membership, support youth and family programs, assist in educating the public of the role of agriculture in today's world, and to support good sportsmanship and ethical behavior in our youth.

The Grange Juniors and Youth are a sanctioned body of the California State Grange, and made up of youth from the age of 5 through 19 years old. The projects displayed at fairs by members are the results of their efforts under supervision of volunteer adults. The official uniform of the Grange Juniors and Youth consist of new blue jeans and white button down shirts with long or short sleeves. Red waist vests with the Grange emblem on the back. Black or brown belt with the appropriate buckle, black, or brown boots. No hats or headgear to be worn while showing.

NOTE: Grange members must be 9 years old on or before January 1st (Local Rule #26) to be eligible to exhibit large livestock at the Antelope Valley Fair. A member can exhibit as a member until the end of the calendar year in which the member becomes 19. Members must own sheep, goat, or swine 60 days and a steer project 120 days prior to opening of fair.

3. NO LIVE PLANTS may be used in display.
4. All needlework backs MUST BE LEFT OPEN for judging.
5. Items must be ready for display when checked in.
6. Items for exhibits must be marked with age and year in project.
7. Ceramics must be earthenware and kiln-fired.

8. HANDICRAFTS include arts and crafts that do not fit in any other class.
9. Member should select articles to do with their ability and will be judged on neatness and artistry of the exhibit.

- 1. Entry form must list type of produce, and the method of process used (canning or drying).

2. Age and year in project must be on entry form.
3. Rings and lids must be on jars. Two jars per exhibit will be required so that one may be opened for taste judging. Dried products should be covered in jars.
4. All canning must be in sealed jars or they will be disqualified. Jars which have been opened for judging must be picked up on day of judging or they will be disposed of.
5. Each dried product exhibit must be in a separate jar no smaller than a half pint, and must be half full.
6. Fruit leather should be cut into 12 one inch strips and rolled into cellophane between layers. Do not secure fruit leather strips with cellophane.
