Market Goats must be individually owned 60 days prior to opening day of the Fair. Goats must be free of horns (Scurs less than 1 inch at the longest point). **This will be strictly ENFORCED.** Females cannot show any udder development. All males must be castrated. Goat hair **MUST BE** trimmed to 3/8" (Head to tail above the hocks **MUST** be trimmed). Market Goats showing yearling teeth or lice will be disqualified

California State Rule; III. Judges 7. To encourage high standards, the judge shall award first, second, third place, etc. according to merit. If without merit, the judge shall make no award under any circumstances. The judge may award championships or other awards at his/her discretion for superior exhibits. This applies whether there are one or more exhibits in class.
