QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS: The latest revised edition of the American Standard of Perfection copyright by the American Poultry Assn. Inc. shall be the guide for judging fowls. To win American Poultry Assn. Medals there must be 10 entries competing in each class.

RULES:

1. Definitions and judging procedure as prescribed in the latest edition of the Official Show Rules and the Standard of Perfection of the American Poultry Assn., Inc. shall apply to all District and County Fair Poultry Shows except in such instances where they are in conflict with rules and regulations prescribed by the Department of Food and Agriculture.
2. Birds will be shown and judged in the proper classes and Division for breed, variety, age and sex only. If no class is offered, no awards may be made. Disqualified birds and those absent at the time of judging do not count when computing the number of exhibits in a class.
3. A Judge may excuse a bird from competition if it appears fatigued or out of condition but the bird shall be counted as an entry.
4. All birds must be banded with legibly numbered bands (prefer plastic or metal bands) prior to cooping at the Fair.
5. **NO CHANGES IN CLASS CAN BE MADE AFTER ENTRIES ARE RECEIVED. SUBSTITUTIONS MAY BE MADE IN THE SAME CLASS AS THE ORIGINAL ENTRY.**
6. Any bird showing any evidence of disease will be immediately removed from the show.
7. Management reserves the right to double coop, females of the same variety owned by one exhibitor.
8. Birds will be fed and cared for by the Fair. Only Superintendents, assistants and judges shall handle birds. Exhibitor may not handle birds once they have been cooped, except for Jr. Showmanship.
9. Eggs must be turned over to the superintendent.
10. Judge may divide and judge division by breed if sufficient entries warrant.
11. The Fair is in no way responsible for errors on entry forms.
12. No exhibitor may receive more than two cash awards in any one class.
13. There will be NO SPECIAL FEEDING. Feed is furnished by the Fair and all feeding and care is provided by qualified help.
14. Any animal not removed from Fair-grounds during the appointed release time will become the property of the Fair to be disposed of or given away.

15. The Judges decision is final. (See State Rule III I#6)

MEDALS will be awarded to Champion Fowl in each of the following by APA and ABA:

LARGE FOWL: American, English, Mediterranean, Continental, all other large fowl breeds

BANTAM: Modern Game, Old English Game, Single Comb Clean Legged other than game, Rose Comb Clean Legged, all other Comb Clean Legged or Feather Legged.
