RULES:

1. All rabbits must be permanently and legibly ear marked in the animal's left ear and correspond with those written on the entry form. Any duplication of ear markings by one exhibitor in the same class or illegible ear markings will be eliminated.
2. THERE WILL BE NO TATTOOING AT THE TIME OF CHECK-IN.
3. All rabbits are subject to health inspection upon arrival.
4. Substitutions shall be allowed only if in the same sex, class, variety and breed.
5. All animals are entered at owner's risk. (See Local Rule #1)
6. Antelope Valley Fair shall not be responsible for any special trophy or premium donated unless those donated have been delivered to the show committee before the end of the show.
7. Disputes see Local Rule #13.
8. Any animal not removed from Fairgrounds during the appointed release time will become the property of the Fair.
9. There will be NO SPECIAL FEEDING. Feed is furnished by the Fair and all feeding and care is provided by qualified help.
10. **BREED, VARIETY OR COLOR, SEX, DIVISION, CLASS AND EAR NUMBER MUST APPEAR ON ENTRY FORM.**
11. Youth may not enter in both open and junior shows that are held on the same day.

***Substitutions will not be accepted after the deadline. Notification of "no shows" would be appreciated (Rabbit Department Rule #4)**

RULES:

1. All rabbits must be permanently and legibly earmarked in the animal's left ear and must correspond with entry form. Any duplication of ear markings by one exhibitor in the same class or illegible ear markings will be eliminated.
2. THERE WILL BE NO TATTOOING AT THE TIME OF CHECK-IN.
3. Substitutions shall be allowed only if in the same sex, class, variety and breed.
4. All animals are entered at owners risk. (See Local Rule #1)
5. Antelope Valley Fair shall not be responsible for any special trophy or premium donated unless those donated have been delivered to the show committee before the end of the show.
6. Disputes see Local Rule #13.
7. Any animal not removed from Fair-grounds during the appointed release time, will become the property of the Fair to be disposed of or given away.
8. There will be NO SPECIAL FEED-ING. Feed is furnished by the Fair and all feeding and care is provided by qualified help.
9. **BREED, VARIETY OR COLOR, SEX, DIVISION, CLASS AND EAR NUMBER MUST APPEAR ON ENTRY FORM.**
10. Animals for Showmanship must be entered in Junior Rabbit Show and must show ear number on entry form. Showmanship will be held the same day as the Junior Rabbit Show.
11. Youth may not enter both open and youth shows held on the same day. Youth exhibitors may enter sanctioned youth shows through the age of 18 years. Adults cannot show in youth classes at any time. Youth exhibitors must be able to handle their own animals. Youth exhibitors are not required to carry their animals to the table.
