

The AV Fair Kiwanis Junior Livestock Auction

Each year, members of 4-H, FFA, Grange organizations and Independent exhibitors raise livestock to be sold at the annual Kiwanis Junior Livestock Auction, held during the Antelope Valley Fair. Along with the responsibilities of caring for the animals, the individuals involved learn dedication and respect. They come to understand the rewards of hard work that comes with financial responsibilities. Buyers range from large and small local business owners to corporate offices and families. In 2008, over 385 animals were eligible for the auction in several divisions including: Market Goat, Sheep, Beef, Swine and the Champion and Reserve Champion Chickens, Rabbits and Turkeys. This year's auction is Wednesday, August 26, 9 a.m. and a new addition to the Auction is that Meat Pens will now include the Champions as well as the next two highest pen placing for the chickens, turkeys and rabbits. RULES:

1. **New:** Champion, Reserve Champion and **the next two highest placing Lots will sell at auction.**
2. The exhibitor must be nine (9) years old before January 1 of the current year.
3. Rabbits must be of the same breed and color. Rabbits must be kindled and owned by exhibitor.
4. Rabbits must be tattooed prior to cooping.
5. Exhibitors entering this division may furnish their own containers. The Fair is not responsible for the return or condition thereof.
6. NO SPECIAL FEEDING. Feeding is furnished by the Fair. Feeding and care is provided by qualified help.
7. Tattoo number must appear on entry form.
8. Rabbits not picked up at the appointed time become the property of the AV Fair.
9. **Exhibitor may sell only one (1) lot unless they own both the Overall Supreme Champion and Supreme Reserve Champion.**

LIMIT: One (1) entry per class per exhibitor. Entries may be limited – State Rule I #9

No vehicles on the grounds after 2 p.m. Mon. - Fri. and 10 a.m. Sat. and Sunday

RULES:

1. Two birds of the same sex shall constitute one entry.
2. Birds must be of same breed.
3. Birds must be banded before cooping (see Open Poultry Show Rule #4)
4. Exhibitor must be nine (9) years old before January 1st of current year.
5. Champion, Reserve Champion and the **next two highest placing Lots will sell at auction.**
6. Exhibitor may sell only one (1) unless they own both the Overall Supreme Champion and Supreme Reserve Champion.
7. Birds cannot be over 70 days old and must be owned and in possession by the exhibitor for a minimum of 30 days.
8. Birds not picked up at the appointed time will become the property of the AV Fair.

LIMIT: One (1) entry per class per exhibitor. Entries may be limited – State Rule I #9

Birds will be limited to the first 70 entries. The receipt number on the entry form (after PAID IN FULL) will establish the order.

No vehicles on the grounds after 2 p.m. Mon. - Fri. and 10 a.m. Sat. and Sunday

RULES:

1. Birds must be 16 to 20 weeks of age at the time of Fair and a maximum weight of 45 lbs.
2. Exhibitors must own and be in possession of birds by entry deadline.
3. Due to space, a maximum of 70 entries will be accepted. An entry is accepted when entered online/in person AND PAID IN FULL. If entries have reached a 70 limit maximum a waiting list will be used on a first come basis.
4. Exhibitors may enter 1 tom and 1 hen.
5. Birds must be banded before cooping (see Open Poultry Show Rule #4).
6. Exhibitor must be nine (9) years old before January 1 of current year.
7. Champion, Reserve Champion and the next two highest placing Lots will sell at auction.
8. Birds not picked up at the appointed time will become the property of the AV Fair.
9. Exhibitor may sell only one (1) unless they own both the Overall Supreme Champion and Supreme Reserve Champion.
