FIRST AMENDMENT EXPRESSION RULES AND APPLICATION

Groups or individuals may conduct First Amendment Expression outside the fenced area of the fairgrounds from An 8' x 8' location located near the main entrance and may in no manner interfere with the normal pedestrian or traffic flow, or which may constitute a traffic hazard as deemed by Security or Management personnel. The Association reserves the right to impose any other reasonable restrictions such as location, number of people, and shall have the right to prohibit the distribution of obscene or offensive materials to the public.

All groups or individuals will be subject to parking fees when parking on the fairgrounds property.

Use of bullhorns is prohibited. The Association is not responsible for providing shade or shade structures. Groups and individuals are responsible for shade structures that **MUST** be secured with adequate weights that withstand thirty (30) mile per hour wind, **NO EXCEPTIONS**. Structures deemed unsafe by security or management personnel, will be asked to be removed. The Association does not provide tables and/or chairs.

Liability insurance is required for all groups and individuals. If you do not have insurance, you may purchase it through the Association for a nominal fee. Please see the attached insurance requirements.

At no time may an individual or a group have the right to place any literature on the buildings, vehicles of patrons, or any property of the Association. Literature must be secured in a manner that prevents it from blowing away. Individuals or groups will be responsible to remove any debris that blows away.

An application must be completed and on file prior to occupancy of space.
